Dress Code

1. Pants with holes in them (skin exposed) above the knee are prohibited.
2. Pajamas, slippers, skirts and/or shorts, shorter than fingertip length, clothing revealing midriff, clothing with profane, vulgar, distracting and/or derogatory slogans, tank tops, chains on pants, or other revealing clothing including exposed undergarments are prohibited.
3. No head coverings unless required by program safety rules.
4. No wearing of jewelry in pierced body parts that violate Vocational Program(s) safety rules.
5. No sunglasses shall be worn in the building with the exceptions of prescription transition lenses, required for lab safety, or medical excuse.
6. Backpacks, briefcases, gym bags or similar carry-all must be stored in the student's locker or last period class during the day. Purses should not be larger than a standard piece of paper.
7. No trench coats allowed in the building.
