I hope this communication finds you all well and that you enjoyed a safe, healthy, and fun summer break!

School is set to begin on August 24th. Due to the fluidity of information regarding COVID 19, this packet includes the Pike CTC's Restart/Reopening Guide, School Reference Quick Guide, and other information pertinent to the beginning of school. The Pike CTC administration has worked with great intention and care to develop a program so students can return to school safely. It is our belief that CTC students need to be in class 5 days a week because they develop through hands-on learning that happens most effectively in the lab and classroom settings. We have worked in collaboration with state and local health departments and the Ohio Department of Education to prepare for our opening and will be following all necessary precautions and industry safety protocols with students. Such issues as face coverings, temperature checks, and symptom checks are addressed in the enclosed Restart/Reopening Guide and reference guide.

In order to accommodate smaller crowds and families' work schedules, we are pleased to announce that the Pike CTC Junior Orientation is August 17-20th. Tuesday, August 18<sup>th</sup> – HVAC/Auto/Business/Culinary (1 p.m. to 8 p.m.)

Wednesday, August 19<sup>th</sup> – Electricity/Building Maintenance/Public Safety (1 p.m. to 8 p.m.)

Thursday, August 20<sup>th</sup> – Patient Care/Med Tech/Basic Food Service/ETECH/HFC (1 p.m. to 8 p.m.)

Please take some time to read the enclosed documents prior to orientation, so you can ask questions when you arrive. As you already know, this situation changes daily, so these documents are not all inclusive and may be adapted as necessary. We will do our best to keep you informed via the CTC's website and/or All Call phone system. We know that you will maintain a positive attitude and cooperate with staff and teachers. We are all here to do the very best we can and to help you succeed!
