- 1. Pants with holes in them (skin exposed) above the knee are prohibited.
- 2. Pajamas, slippers, skirts and/or shorts, shorter than fingertip length, clothing revealing midriff, clothing with profane, vulgar, distracting and/or derogatory slogans, tank tops, chains on pants, or other revealing clothing including exposed undergarments are prohibited.
- 3. No head coverings unless required by program safety rules.
- 4. No wearing of jewelry in pierced body parts that violate Vocational Program(s) safety rules.
- 5. No sunglasses shall be worn in the building with the exceptions of prescription transition lenses, required for lab safety, or medical excuse.
- 6. Backpacks, briefcases, gym bags or similar carry-all must be stored in the student's locker or last period class during the day. Purses should not be larger than a standard piece of paper.
- 7. No trench coats allowed in the building.
